Information you should know:

On December 11, 2013 the City Council voted to adopt a new dog license fee schedule effective January 10, 2014. Fees are now due annually on June 30th. Owners must provide a current veterinarian's certificate of rabies vaccination and a photograph of your pet when applying for a license. The City pays \$1,300.00 annually, as its share of maintaining the Humboldt County Animal Shelter. Licensing fees help defray that cost and provide a required central registry of rabies vaccinations. All dogs must be restrained on a leash when not secured in their owner's yard. Licensing is the most efficient way for you to be reunited with your pet if it gets lost. State Law and Trinidad Municipal Code require that your dog has an active rabies vaccination and be licensed. Please call Trinidad City Hall at 677-0223 with any questions or to report a problem. Hours of operation are from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm Monday through Friday.
